Deputation and Study Leave for Higher Study (Abroad).

Mr. Md. Nur-E-Alom Siddique (SAP ID: 18907295), Joint Director (Research), Chief Economist's Unit, Bangladesh Bank, Head Office, Dhaka has been granted deputation and study leave as stated below for attending PhD in Economics in Deakin University, Australia in light of the guarantee bonds submitted by him on 11/02/2024 under the following terms and conditions:

02. Conditions:

- During deputation/study leave 50% of his net salary and allowances (after adjusting PF, income tax and others) and 50% of all his bonuses will be adjusted with his car advance;
 - He is obligated to work in Bangladesh Bank for a minimum of 06 (six) years after returning from deputation/study leave. If he resigns before the aforementioned period or stays absent from office without the concerned authority's prior approval, Bank will recover all the salaries and allowances paid during deputation/study leave period from his guarantors;
 - If he abandons or fails to successfully complete the program, he will be obligated to return all the money received as salaries and allowances during deputation;
 - If he does not return to the country after deputation, her guarantors shall be obligated to pay Tk.4,00,000.00 for compensation as per Circular No. Prasha(Prabi)24/98-5 dated 23/09/1998 of the Administration Department;
 - If he does not join the bank on time, his guarantors shall be liable to pay all of his advances with interest;
 - The period of deputation/study leave will not be extended under any circumstances;
 - The approved program and the university can not be changed under any circumstances;
 - Over the period of deputation/study leave all of his salaries and allowances will be disbursed to concerned account in local currency;
 - Bangladesh Bank or Government will not bear any expense for his study or other purpose while he stays in Australia;
 - He must notify his contact address without delay after his arrival in Australia to training.hrd@bb.org.bd/gm.hrd2@bb.org.bd through email;
 - Within 07 (seven) days of his arrival in Australia he must report to the Bangladesh Embassy located there;
 - The progress report of his study must be sent to training.hrd@bb.org.bd/gm.hrd2@bb.org.bd by email to the Director (HRD-2) of Human Resources Department-2 along with documentary evidence on half-yearly basis;
 - He will compulsorily join to HRD-1, Bangladesh Bank on the next working day after returning home;
 - He has to submit the degree certificate/documentary evidence to Human Resources Department-2 and Thesis/Dissertation/Term Paper (both in hard copy and soft copy format) in the Research Department (Library) within 07 days of joining the Bank after study;
- He will be treated as released from his duties after the close of business of 18 February, 2024.
