The Tenderer shall have to furnish work completion certificate in this

respect from officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent. c) Liquid asset/Credit facility shall be Tk 5.50 Crore (Taka Five Point Five Zero Crore) only.

d) Tenderer shall have to fulfill the qualification criteria stipulated in the ITT, TDS, GCC, PCC and other Terms & Conditions of the Tender Documents; failing which the Tender shall be rejected and

considered as non-responsive.

v) PG3-1 and PG3-2 form shall be completed and signed by the Authorized Signatory on the Letter-Head Pad attached by Scanning during submitting tender through Web and original shall be sent to the General Manager(Engineering), Common Services Department-2 within scheduled time as per TDS.
