Dear Sirs,

**Facilitating the receipt of inward remittance from alternative entities
by licenced freight forwarders**

Please refer to FEPD-1 Circular No. 08, dated May 07, 2026 and its subsequent circulars in terms of which Authorized Dealers (ADs) are allowed regarding freight charges recovered from the overseas importer through their counterpart freight forwarders abroad and repatriated the same to Bangladesh through normal banking channel.

02. To bring wider flexibility and facilitate transactions, it has been decided that licenced freight forwarders are permitted to receive inward remittances from alternative entities such as importers, buying houses, or any other foreign arranging parties, in addition to their overseas counterpart freight forwarders.

03. Other relevant instructions shall remain unchanged. Please bring the contents of the circular to the notice of your relevant clientele.

This circular is issued with the authority vested to Bangladesh Bank under Section 20(3) of Foreign Exchange Regulation (FER) Act, 1947.
