

REVIEW OF IMPORT PAYMENTS OF GOODS AND SERVICES, 2019-2020

Import Payments of Goods: The total merchandise Import Payments of Bangladesh (including imports of EPZ) during the years 2019-2020 and 2018-2019 amounted to Taka 412852.4 crore (or US\$ 48699.8 million) and Taka 471077.5 crore (or US\$ 56060.8 million) respectively, reflecting a 13.13% decrease in dollar terms.

Import Payments of Services: The total Import Payments of Services during the years 2019-2020 and 2018-2019 amounted to taka 58794.1 crore (or US\$ 6935.0 Million) and taka 57344.8 crore (or US\$ 6823.3 Million) respectively, reflecting a 1.64 % increase in dollar terms.

The overall position of Import Payments of Goods and Services in Taka and US dollar for the years 2019-2020 and 2018-2019 are shown in Table –I(A) and Table-I (B) respectively:

Import payments during the financial year 2019-2020 amounted to Taka 386249.0 crore as against Taka 438540.5 crore during the previous year. **Commodity group-wise Import Payments under (Cash+Buyer's Credit+
IDB/ITFC Loan+ Loans & Grants):**

The Import Payments during the year 2019-2020 amounted to Tk. 412852.4 crore as against Tk. 471077.5 crore during the previous year showing an decrease of Taka 58255.1 crore (or 12.36%). Commodity-wise classification revealed decreases over the previous year under textiles and textile articles (-Taka 12443.6 crore), mineral products (-Taka 9457.9 crore), machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment, parts thereof, sound recorders and reproducers, television image and sound recorders and reproducers, and parts and accessories of such articles (-Taka 17423.9 crore), Products of the Chemical or Allied Industries (-Taka 1818.9 crore), base metals and articles of base metal (-Taka 3329.1 crore), plastics and rubber and articles thereof (-Taka 336.5 crore), Vehicles, aircraft, vessels and associated transport equipment. (-Taka 9454.5 crore), Animal or vegetable fats and oils and their cleavage products; prepared edible fats; animal or vegetable waxes (-Taka 2005.1 crore), Prepared foodstuffs; Beverages, Spirits and vinegar; Tobacco and manufactured tobacco substitutes (-Taka 894.1 crore), pulp of wood or of other fibrous cellulosic material; recovered (waste and scrap) paper or paperboard, paper and paperboard and articles thereof (-Taka 1228.2 crore), optical, photographic, cinematographic measuring, checking, precision, medical or surgical instruments and apparatus; clock and watches, musical instruments, parts and accessories thereof (-Taka 233.7 crore), Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles (-Taka 228.3 crore), articles of stone, plaster, cement asbestos, mica or similar materials, ceramic products; glass and glassware (-Taka 443.9 crore), foot wear, headgear, umbrellas, sun umbrellas, walking sticks, seat-sticks, whips, ridding crops and parts thereof; (Taka 134.6 crore), Natural or Cultured Pearls, Precious or Semiprecious Stones, Precious Metals, Metals Clad with Precious Metal and Articles thereof; Imitation Jewellery; Coin (-Taka 21.9 crore) and Works of Art, Collectors Pieces and Antiques (-Taka 33.6 crore).

On the other hand, Commodity-wise classification revealed increases over the previous year were recorded under: Vegetable Products (+Taka 6300.1 crore), Live Animals and Animal Products (+Taka 145.8 crore), Raw Hides and Skins, Leather and Articles Thereof; Saddlery and Harness; Travel Goods, Handbags nad Similar Containers; Articles of Animal Gut (+Taka 81.9 crore), Arms and Ammunition; Parts and Accessories Thereof (+Taka 666.4 crore) and Wood and Articles of Wood; Wood Charcoal; Cork and Articles of Cork; Manufactures of Straw, of Esparto or Other Plaiting Materials; Basketware & Wickerwork (+Taka 49.8 crore).

The destinational pattern of imports during the year under review revealed that People's Republic of China topped the list of suppliers which earned Taka 97399.0 crore (or 25.2%) from export to Bangladesh during the year 2019-2020 as compared to Taka 114593.5 crore (or 26.1%) during the preceding year. The second highest seller was the India which supplied merchandise worth Taka 49115.7 crore (or 12.7%) during the year 2019-2020 under review as compared to Taka 64253.7 crore (or 14.7%) during the previous year.

Next to India, the third highest seller was United States of America (USA) which supplied merchandise worth Taka 18029.5 crore (or 4.7%) during 2019-2020 as compared to Taka 14930.9 crore (or 3.4%) during the preceding year.

Indonesia being the fourth supplier in order of rank, sold goods worth Taka 16135.6 crore (or 4.2%) during 2019-2020 as compared to Taka 16305.3 crore (or 3.7%) during the previous year.

Japan fifth being the supplier in order of importance, sold goods worth Taka 14591.6 crore (or 3.8%) during 2019-2020 as compared to Taka 15517.4 (or 3.5%) during the previous year.

Singapore, Malaysia, Brazil, Qatar, Saudia Arabia, Korea republic of, Canada, Germany, Taiwan: Province of China, Thailand, Russian Federation, United Arab Emirates (UAE), Australia, Argentina and Vietnam followed in descending order of magnitude in respect of import payments and accounted for Taka 14547.6 crore (or 3.8%), Taka 14165.0 crore (or 3.7%), Taka 12118.0 crore (or 3.1%), Taka 10328.9 crore (or 2.7%), Taka 9254.0 crore (or 2.4%), Taka 8736.7 crore (or 2.3%), Taka 7999.2 crore (or 2.1%), Taka 7291.0 crore (or 1.9%), Taka 7201.1 crore (or 1.9%), Taka 6795.2 crore (or 1.8%), Taka 6631.0 crore (or 1.7%), Taka 6103.2 crore (or 1.6%) Taka 5506.6 crore (or 1.4 %), Taka 5164.5 crore (or 1.3%) and Taka 4705.7 crore (or 1.2%) respectively.



Import Payments classified by Bloc/Group/Community:

Import payments under cash, buyer's credit, loans & grants, IDB/ITFC loan and other unclassified imports when classified by countries in a bloc/group/economic community revealed that the Other Asian Countries topped the list, selling goods worth Taka 131765.5 crore (or 34.1 %) of the total import payments during the period under review as compared to Taka 155451.6 crore (or 35.3 %) in the preceding year.

The second highest seller were the member countries of Organisation of Islamic Conference (OIC) which accounted for an amount of Taka 82093.1 crore (or 21.3%) during the year under review as against Taka 87341.1 crore (or 19.8 %) during the preceding year.

The third highest seller were the member countries of SAARC which accounted for an amount of Taka 57746.9 crore (or 15.0%) during the year under review as compared to Taka 68806.4 crore (or 15.6%) during the preceding year.

The fourth highest seller were the member countries of Asian Clearing Union (ACU) which accounted for an amount of Taka 55673.7 crore (or 14.4%) during the year under review as against Taka 71260.0 crore (or 16.2 %) during the preceding year.

ASEAN, D-8, OPEC, EU, NAFTA and Other European countries followed in descending order of magnitude in respect of import payments as follows: Taka 54710.7 crore (or 14.2%), 38626.2 crore (10.0%), Taka 33018.2 crore (or 8.5%), Taka 26585.1 crore (or 6.9%), Taka 26226.2 crore (or 6.8%), and Taka 17119.1 crore (or 4.4%) respectively.

Table-V(A) (Taka in crore) and V(B) (In Million US\$) shows the comparative position of import payments to countries classified into bloc/group/community etc. during the year 2019-2020 and 2018-2019 alongwith their relative shares in the total import payments of Bangladesh.

Imports by Export Processing Zone (EPZ):

In order to achieve rapid economic growth of the country by increasing the inflow of foreign investment, particularly through industrialisation, special steps have been taken since 1980 by setting up Export Processing Zone (EPZ) in the country in Chittagong (Halishahar), Dhaka (Savar) and Khulna (Mongla) where favourable facilities/ assistance are provided to the potential investors, both Bangladeshi and foreigners. The Chittagong Export Processing Zone (CEPZ) started from 1983-84 while the Dhaka Export Processing Zone (DEPZ) started from 1993-94. Later, EPZs have also been established in Mongla of Khulna, Ishurdi of Pabna, Comilla, Uttara of Syedpur in the district of Nilphamary, Adamjee of Narayanganj and Karnaphuli of Chittagong where the investments are classified into three types i.e., A-type (100% foreign investment), B-type (Joint venture investment between Bangladeshi and foreigners) and C-type (100% Bangladeshi entrepreneur's investment).

At the end of June, 2020 type-wise number of functioning enterprises in EPZ area are shown in Table-VI.
