

## Review of Export Receipts of Goods and Services, 2019-2020

### Export Receipts of Goods:

Total export receipts of goods of Bangladesh (including exports of EPZ) during the financial years 2019-2020, 2018-2019 and 2017-2018 amounted to Tk. 265453.5 crore, Tk. 296983.9 crore and Tk. 267179.8 crore or US \$ 31316 million, US \$ 35341 million and US \$ 32537 million respectively.

### Export Receipts of Services:

Total export receipts of services of Bangladesh during the financial years 2019-2020, 2018-2019 and 2017-2018 amounted to Tk. 47533.2 crore, Tk. 50200.5 crore and Tk. 35069.2 crore or US \$ 5606 million, US \$ 5974 million and US \$ 4264 million respectively.

The overall position of export receipts in Taka and US dollar for the years 2019-2020, 2018-2019 and 2017-2018 are shown in tables 1(A) and 1(B) respectively.

## **Exports Receipts of Goods on Cash Terms (Excluding EPZ)**

Export earnings in 2019-2020 stood at Tk. 223548.4 crore as against Tk.246308.3 crore in the preceding year. The main items of cash exports during the year under review were Readymade Garments (Tk. 190874.7 crore), Jute and Jute Manufactures (Tk. 7186.1 crore), Leather and Leather Manufactures (Tk. 4398.1 crore), Fish, Shrimps and Prawns (Tk. 3442.8 crore), Home Textile (Tk. 3097.8 crore), Vegetable Products (Tk. 1381.4 crore), Pharmaceutical Products (Tk. 879.6 crore), Plastic and Plastic Products (Tk. 537.8 crore), Bicycle (Tk. 450.9 crore), Terry Towel (Tk. 128.4 crore), Handicrafts (Tk. 140.1 crore) and Petroleum and Petroleum Products (Tk.9.1 crore). The major partner countries were the U.S.A (Tk. 33766.8 crore), Germany (Tk. 33003.4 crore), the U.K (Tk. 22800.0 crore), Spain (Tk. 16316.6 crore), France (Tk. 13186.3 crore), Italy (Tk. 10219.1 crore), Poland (Tk. 8707.2 crore), India (Tk. 7338.7 crore), Netherlands (Tk. 7055.7 crore), Canada (Tk. 6539.6 crore) and Japan (Tk. 6403.4 crore).

## **Commodity- wise Export Receipts (Excluding EPZ)**

During the year 2019-2020 the earnings through traditional items i.e. Jute Manufactures (Tk. 6146.1 crore), Raw Jute (Tk. 1040 crore) and Tea-all sorts (Tk. 20.9 crore) and through non-traditional items (Tk. 216341.4 crore). Among the non-traditional items, Readymade Garments have emerged individually as the most important sector. Readymade Garments accounted for Tk. 190874.7 crore (84.5 %) in 2019-2020 as compared to Tk. 212355.7 crore (86.2 %) in 2018-2019.

Commodity classification of export earnings for the current year revealed increases over the previous year under : Jute and Jute Manufactures (Tk. 753.2 crore), Vegetable Products (Tk. 405.0 crore), Pharmaceutical Products (33.1 crore), Bicycle (Tk. 14.9 crore) and Fertilizer (Tk. 4.6 crore) and on the other hand export earnings through Readymade Garments including hosiery (Tk. 21481.0 crore), Leather and Leather Manufactures (Tk. 739.0 crore), Home Textile (Tk. 299.8 crore), Petroleum and Petroleum Products (Tk. 179.3 crore), Plastic and Plastic Products (Tk. 167.2 crore), Fish, Shrimps and Prawns (Tk. 113.5 crore) , Terry Towel (Tk. 75.0 crore) and Handicrafts (Tk. 12.5 crore) are decreased.

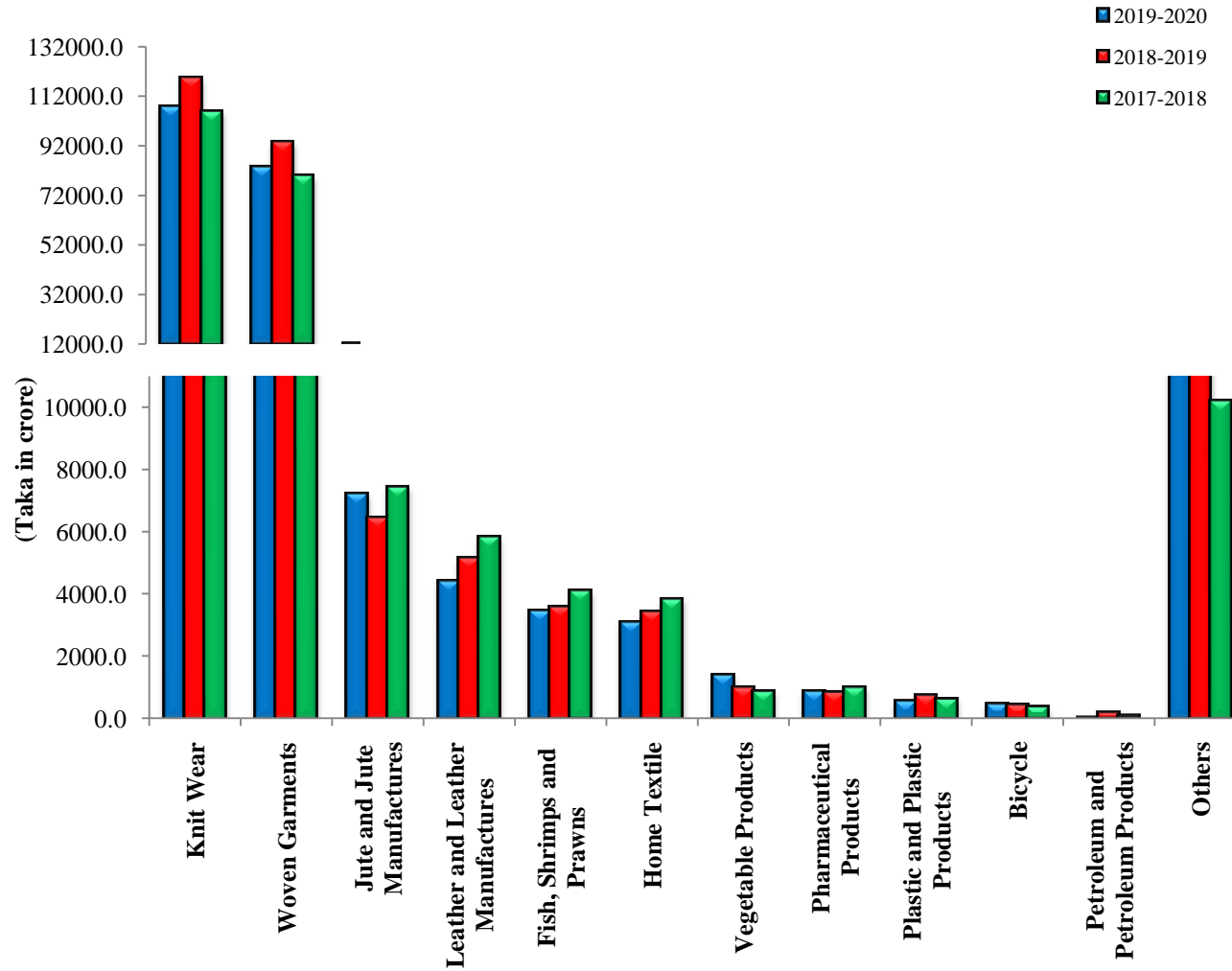

## **Direction of Exports Earnings (Excluding EPZ)**

As regard the destinational pattern of export, the U.S.A. were the most prominent buyer which bought goods worth Tk. 33766.8 crore (15.1%) during the year under review as compared to Tk. 37750.1 crore (15.3%) and Tk. 32561.0 crore (14.8%) in the previous year 2018-2019 and 2017-2018 respectively. The principal items of export to the U.S.A. were Readymade Garments (Tk. 31536.0 crore), Leather and Leather Manufactures (Tk. 345.9 crore), Home Textiles (Tk. 252.6 crore), Fish, Shrimps & Prawns (Tk. 154.9 crore), Jute Manufactures (Tk. 128.1 crore), Raw Jute (Tk. 9.7 crore) and Handicrafts (Tk. 21.4 crore).

The second largest buyer of Bangladeshi goods was Germany amounted to Tk. 33003.4 crore (14.8%) during the year under review as compared to Tk. 39364.9 crore (16.0%) and Tk. 35148.0 crore (16.0%) during 2018-2019 and 2017-2018 respectively. The major items of export to Germany were: Readymade Garments (Tk. 30849.3 crore), Leather and Leather Manufactures (Tk. 609.2 crore), Home Textiles (Tk. 549.1 crore), Fish, Shrimps & Prawns (Tk. 391.5 crore), Jute Manufactures (Tk.16.4 crore), Raw Jute (Tk. 14.3 crore) and Handicrafts (Tk. 10.5 crore).

The next important trading partner was the U.K. Export earnings from U.K. amounted to Tk. 22800.0 crore (10.2%) during the year 2019-2020 as compared to Tk. 24870 crore (10.1%) and Tk. 23072.9 crore (10.5%) in the previous year 2018-2019 and 2017-2018 respectively. The main items of exports to the U.K. were Readymade Garments (Tk. 21193.6 crore), Fish, Shrimps & Prawns (Tk. 605.8 crore), Home Textiles (Tk. 439.1 crore), Leather and Leather Manufactures (Tk.106.8 crore), Jute Manufactures (Tk. 22.6 crore), Raw Jute (Tk. 22.0 crore) and Handicrafts (Tk. 6.9 crore).

Spain purchased goods worth Tk. 16316.6 crore (7.3%) during the year under review. The shares of Spain in export receipts during 2018-2019 and 2017-2018 were Tk. 16757.0 crore (6.8%) and Tk. 14925.9 crore (6.8%) respectively.

France, Italy, Poland, India, Netherlands, Canada, Japan, Denmark, Australia, Belgium and Sweden followed by descending order of magnitude in respect of our export earnings and accounted for Tk. 13186.3 crore (5.9%), Tk. 10219.1 crore (4.6 %), Tk. 8707.2 crore (3.9%), Tk. 7338.7 crore (3.3%), Tk. 7055.7 crore (3.2%), Tk. 6539.6 crore (2.9 %), 6403.4 crore (2.9 %), Tk. 5454.9 crore (2.4 %), 5018.9 crore (2.2 %), 4712.7 crore (2.1 %) and 4400.2 crore (2.0 %) respectively.

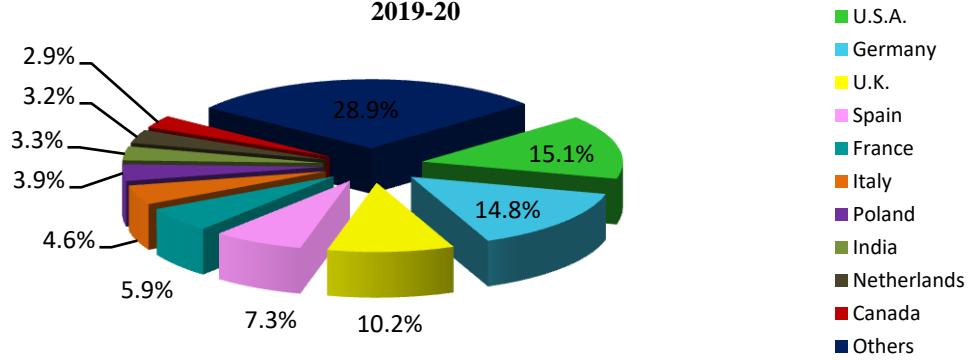

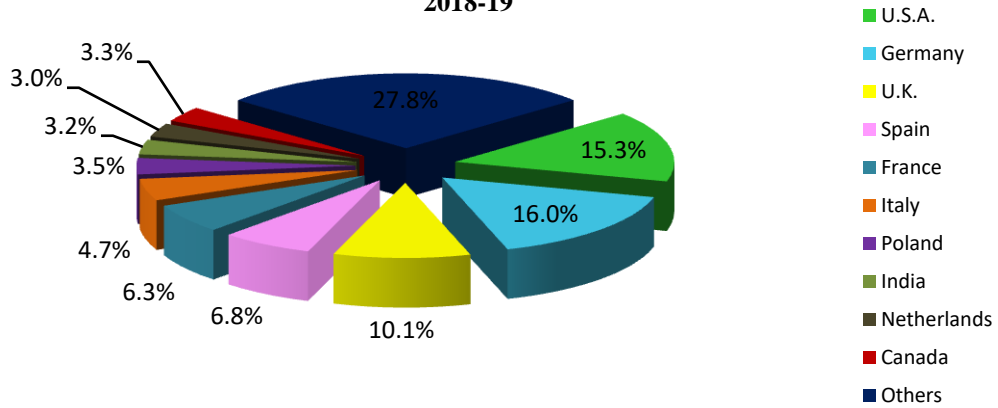

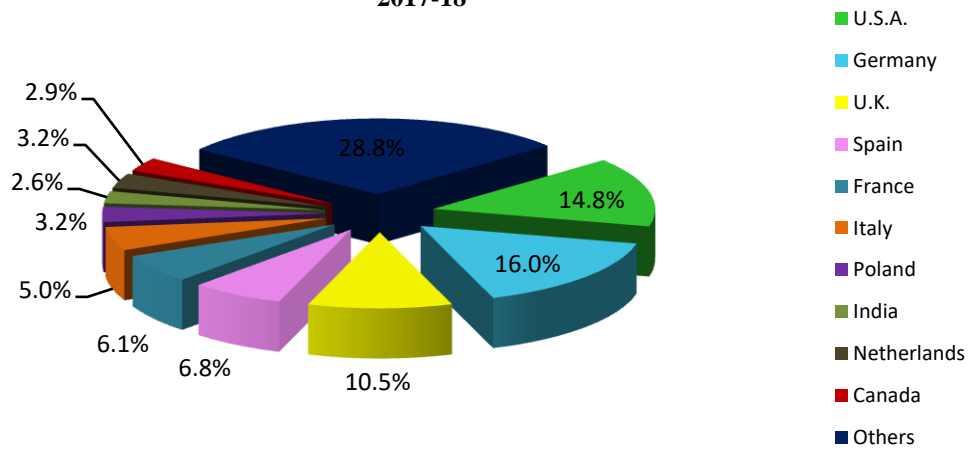
**EXPORT RECEIPTS OF BANGLADESH BY MAJOR TEN COUNTRIES

## Export Receipts by bloc/group/Community (Excluding EPZ)

The destinational pattern of export revealed that the EU member countries topped the buyers' list sharing Tk. 131134.0 crore (58.7%) of the total export receipts during the year under review as against Tk. 145763.1 crore (59.2%) in the preceding year.

The second largest buyer of Bangladeshi goods was the member countries of NAFTA. The shares of NAFTA was Tk. 41593.3 crore (18.6%) of the total exports as compared to Tk. 47235.7 crore (19.2%) during 2018-2019.

Other Asian countries imported Bangladeshi goods worth Tk. 14157.4 crore (6.3%) during the year 2019-2020 as against Tk. 15616.6 crore (6.3%) during the previous year.

The OIC countries share was Tk. 12162.6 crore (5.4%) as against Tk. 11765.3 crore (4.8%) during the previous year.

ACU member countries, Other European countries, SAARC, Developing Eight, OPEC and ASEAN countries accounted for Tk. 8711.3 crore (3.9%), Tk. 8487.3 crore (3.8%), Tk. 8426.5 crore (3.8 %), Tk. 6309.4 crore (2.8 %), Tk. 4841.5 crore (2.2%) and Tk. 4170.1 crore (1.9%) respectively of the total export receipts during the year 2019-2020.

Table-4(A)[Taka in crore] & 4(B)[In million US\$] shows the comparative position of export receipts from countries classified in a block/group/economic community during 2019-2020 and 2018-2019 along with their respective shares in the total export receipts of Bangladesh.

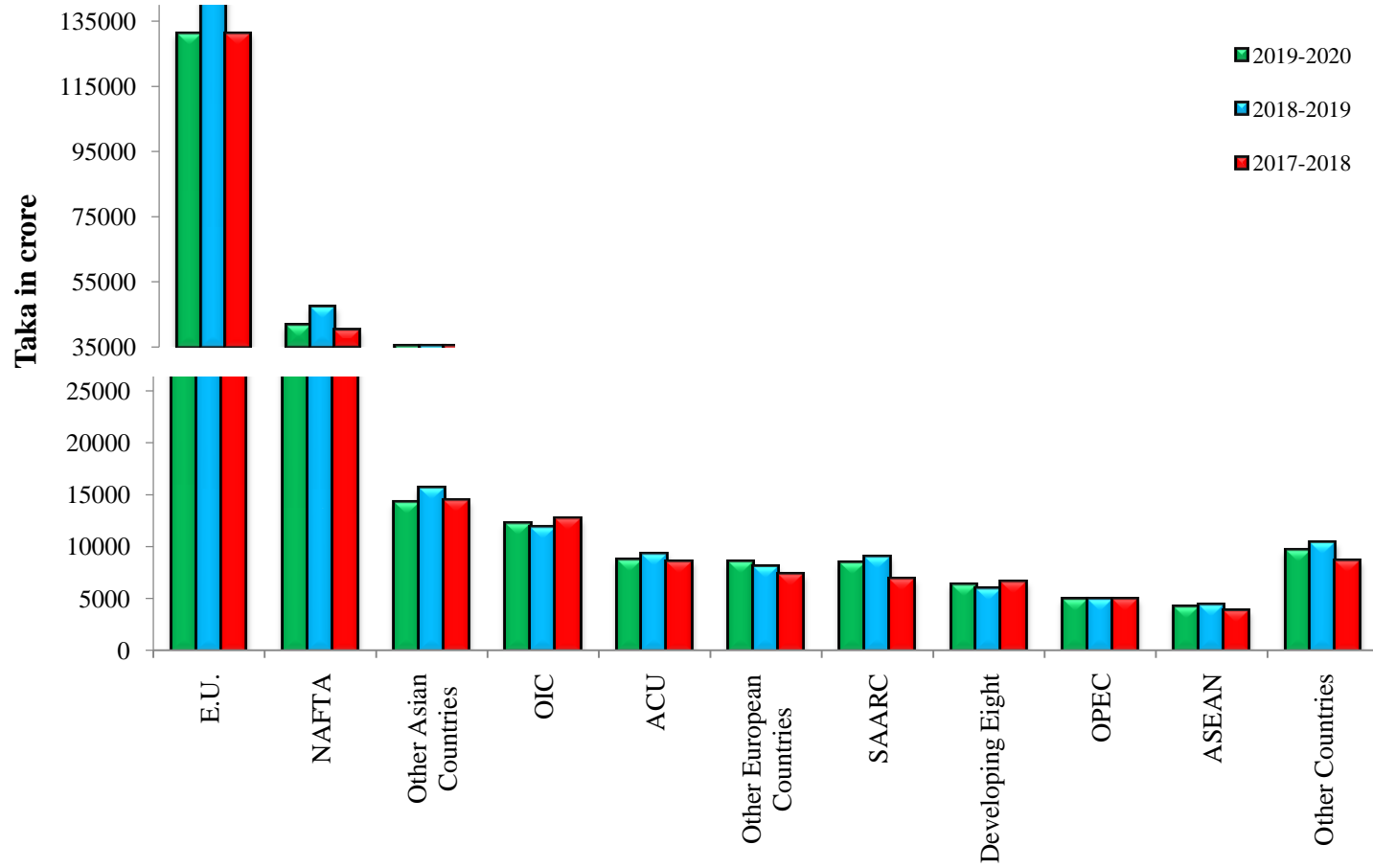

## Export by Export Processing Zones (EPZ)

In order to achieve rapid economic growth of the country by increasing the inflow of foreign investment, particularly through industrialization, special steps have been taken since 1980 by setting up Export processing Zones (EPZ) in the country. Initially three special zones were set up in Chittagong (Halishahar), Dhaka (Savar) and Khulna (Mongla) where favorable facilities/assistance are provided to the potential investors both Bangladeshi and foreigners. The Chittagong Export Processing Zone (CEPZ) started from 1983-84 while the Dhaka Export Processing Zone (DEPZ) started from 1993-94. Later, EPZs have also been established in Mongla of Khulna, Ishwardi of Pabna , Comilla, Uttara of Syedpur in the district of Nilphamary, Adamjee of Narayanganj and Karnaphuli of Chittagong which are classified into three types i.e. A-type (100% foreign investment), B-type (Joint venture between Bangladeshi and foreigners) and C-type (100% Bangladeshi enterprises).
